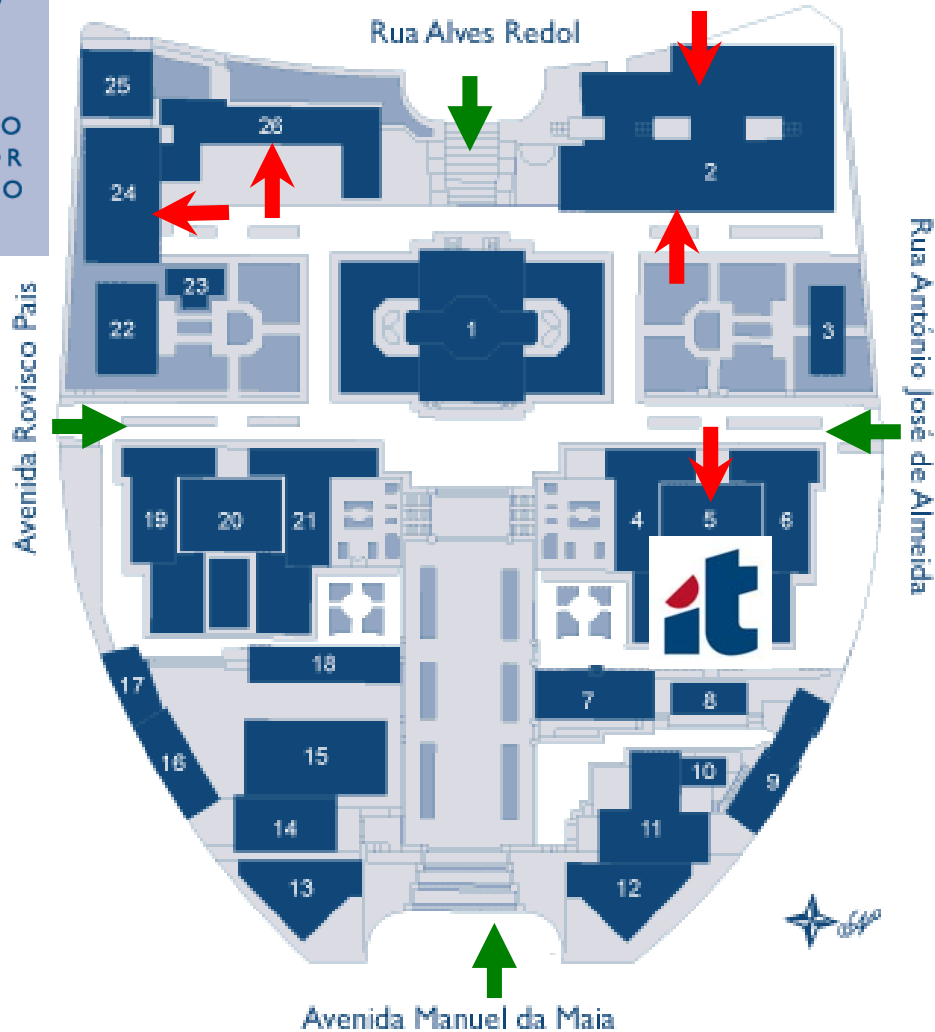
REGISTRATION
